Buyers Notes

- Experts recommend considering multiple options and then narrowing down actual acquisitions based on what residents are being cared for. In other words, do your homework early.
- Note that new federal requirements for enhanced personcentered care went into effect Nov. 28, 2017. Providers must now interview residents about their care preferences, such as how their hygiene is administered (shower, bath, bed-bath) and how often.
- One vendor notes that return shoppers might be surprised by the way the market has expanded feature options, easier-to-use controls, new color schemes and ancillary products.

"Our maintenance [department] wants to be consistent and go with a tub they are familiar with so operationally it's easier for everyone. Tub design is always improving so have someone come out to demonstrate all the features so everyone understands. We also try to get three quotes."
