An innovator in the senior housing space, Charles Turner is the CEO of KARE, a leading solution to solve the labor shortage in senior care. He is also CEO of Invidia for Seniors, a multi-platform company focused on improving the senior housing and care industry. Prior to Invidia, he was the president of Lifewell Senior Living and PinPoint Senior Living where he led development and operating initiatives for the companies.

Charles has been instrumental in identifying and developing nearly a half billion dollars in medical and senior housing projects, including hospitals, medical office buildings and assisted living developments in several states throughout the US Sun Belt.

Additionally, he served as vice president of finance, planning and operations for Attachmate (formerly NetIQ), a \$400 million software company, where he was responsible for financial management, strategic planning activities and real estate. Prior to Attachmate, he worked at BMC Software, where he was responsible for internal strategic planning as well as restructuring the company's real estate portfolio, saving the company more than \$30 million per year in real estate expense from asset sales and lease restructuring.
